

What to do if the fiber optic cable box light is on

The lights on your fiber optic cable box (ONT) indicate its power, network connection, and data status; understanding each light helps identify and resolve issues.

- **Power Light:** A solid green light means the ONT is powered and functioning normally. If it's red or off, check the power cord, outlet, or power strip, and try another outlet if needed. Persistent issues may require contacting your ISP .
- **Optical/Fiber Light:** A green light indicates a stable fiber connection. Red or blinking lights suggest a problem with the fiber signal, such as a loose or damaged cable, or an issue with the ONT's optical receiver .
- **Ethernet/Data Light:** Green indicates successful data transmission to your router or devices. Amber or red may indicate slow, intermittent, or failed data transfer. Ensure cables are securely connected and try different ports or cables if necessary .

- **Alarm Light:** A red alarm light signals an error or fault, such as a loss of power or network connection. If the alarm persists, contact your ISP for assistance .

Troubleshooting Steps

- **Check Power:** Ensure the ONT is plugged into a working outlet and the power strip is on. Press the power button if available .
- **Inspect Cables:** Verify that the fiber cable is securely connected to the PON port and that Ethernet cables are properly connected to your router or gateway .
- **Restart the ONT:** Power cycle the device by unplugging it for 10-30 seconds and then plugging it back in. This can resolve temporary connection issues .
- **Check for Outages:** Log in to your ISP account or check their service status page to see if there is a local network outage affecting your connection .
- **Reset the ONT:** If lights are still abnormal, press and hold the reset button on the ONT for a few seconds. Note that this will temporarily disconnect your internet .
- **Contact Your ISP:** If the problem persists after these steps, contact your internet service provider for further troubleshooting or repair . By following these steps, you can identify whether the light indicates normal operation or a problem and take appropriate action to restore your fiber-optic internet connection.
