- PLTC or VNTC cables: Designed for specific control or signal applications, meeting UL and NEC standards .

- Voltage Rating: Most tray cables are rated for 600 V, but always verify the rating for your application.
- Environmental Resistance: Choose cables resistant to moisture, chemicals, sunlight, and temperature extremes.
- Flame Retardancy: UL 1277 and IEEE 1202 FT4/FT6 tests ensure safety in confined spaces.
- Installation Compliance: Follow NEC Article 392 for cable tray fill, support, and securing requirements . Tray cables simplify wiring in complex installations by providing a self-contained, durable, and code-compliant solution for routing power, control, and instrumentation circuits in cable trays.
